

# MOORE YOUTH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

## CONSTITUTION

### ARTICLE 1: NAME

**Section 1:** The name of this organization shall be **Moore Youth Football Association**. Here in after referred to as "**M.Y.F.A.**". The Association shall operate exclusively as a non-profit organization.

### ARTICLE 2: PURPOSE

**Section 1:** The purpose of this Association is to provide safe, supervised sport activities for the youth of the Moore Community.

### ARTICLE 3: MEMBERSHIP

**Section 1:** Any child attending the Moore Public Schools or living in the Moore Public School District.

**Section 2:** The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of this child shall be eligible for membership in this Association.

**Section 3:** Any adult living in the City of Moore that is interested in furthering the objectives of this Association.

### ARTICLE 4: OFFICIALS

**Section 1: ELECTED:** The President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer shall be nominated and elected by the members of the Association.

**Section 2: APPOINTED:** The newly elected President shall appoint Age Group Coordinators. These appointments must be ratified by a majority vote of the Executive Board.

### ARTICLE 5: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

**Section 1:** The Board of Directors shall be the combined efforts of the Executive Board and the Age Group Coordinators. They shall be the governing body of Association. Such members are to be elected and/or appointed as specified in the Constitution and/or By-laws of this Association.

## **ARTICLE 6: MEETINGS**

**Section 1:** The Executive Board shall meet, as necessary, once a month from January through November.

**Section 2:** The Board of Directors shall meet, as necessary, once a month from April through November.

**Section 3:** The President of the Association may call special meetings.

## **ARTICLE 7: PARLIMENTARY AUTHORITY**

**Section 1:** “Roberts Rules of Order” shall be the authority for parliamentary procedures at all business meetings when other procedures are not specified.

## **ARTICLE 8: AMENDMENTS**

**Section 1:** This Constitution shall remain permanent and effective each year until modified by amendments approved by 95% of the Board of Directors and ratified by a majority of the Association present at a general assembly.
